António Ruano received the first degree in Electronic Engineering and Telecommunications from the University of Aveiro, Portugal in 1982, the master degree in Electrotechnical Engineering from the University of Coimbra, Portugal in 1989, the Ph.D. in Electronic Engineering in 1992 from the University of Wales, UK, and the "Agregação" in Electronic Engineering and Computing from the University of Algarve, in 2004. He was an Assistant in the Department of Mathematics, in 1992-1993, an Assistant in the Department of Electronic Engineering and Telecommunications, in 1984-1992, University of Aveiro. Since 1992 he moved to the University of Algarve, where is currently Associate Professor with "Agregação". He is the Head of its Centre for Intelligent Systems. He has over 200 publications, among books, book chapters, journal and conference papers, in the fields of intelligent computation and applications to control systems and biomedical signal processing.

Dr. Ruano is Chair of the IFAC Computational Intelligence in Control Technical Committee, Chair of Engineering Applications of Artificial Intelligence Prize Selection Committee, and an IEEE Senior Member (Computational Intelligence Society).
